Senior leaders in the school work to promote improvement across the wider system through the Kite Teaching School Alliance.

5. Achievement of Pupils in The School

Achievement and Attainment of pupils is high. Assessment without levels is implemented well and pupil progress is carefully tracked. The attainment and progress of disadvantaged pupils at least match or are rapidly approaching those of other pupils nationally and in the school.

The progress of girls in KS1 is monitored closely.

Phonics is well taught in EYFS and Year 1 and leads to excellent outcomes for pupils.
